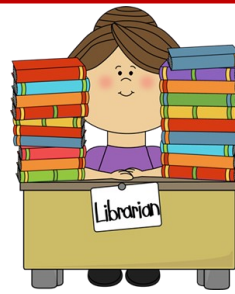
Reading is for Everyone!
