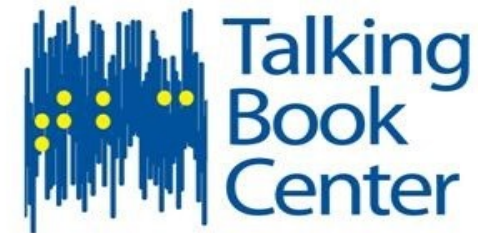
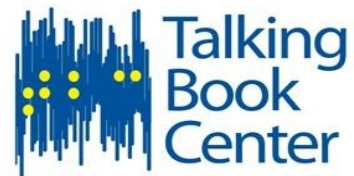

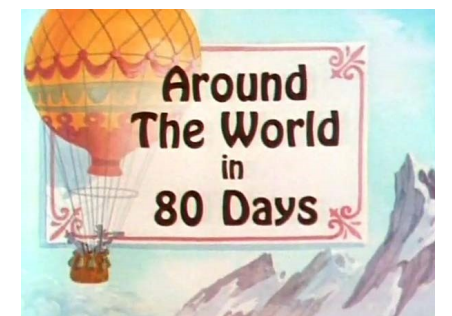
It's hot outside but you can have cool August Adventures with these books! Call the TBC to request titles in the series or search on BARD.

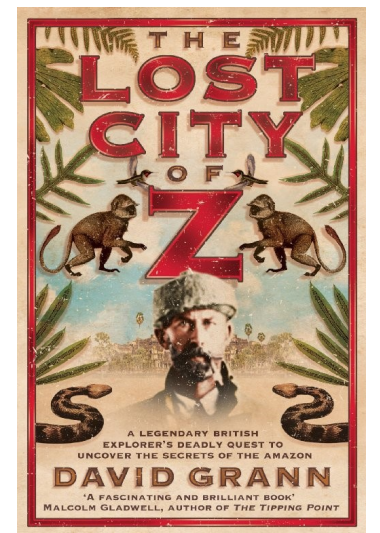

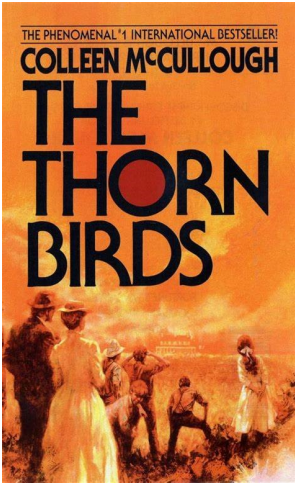

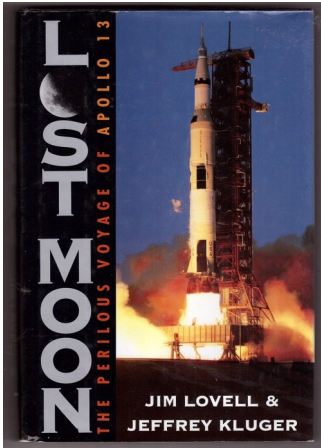
