## Have You Tried Audio Description?

Audio Description for television and movies is defined as narration added to the soundtrack to describe important visual details that cannot be understood from the main soundtrack alone. Audio Description provides information about actions, characters, scene changes, on-screen text, and other visual content and is usually added during existing pauses in dialogue.
