The Challenge

Plow Blade Design Challenge:

Criteria:

- Display or demonstrate a theme of Snow Day or Winter Olympics
- Model kindness through the display, to the extent possible
- Use pictures to represent the theme (minimal words, if any)
- Be neat and colorful

Five students will be selected to have their designs painted onto plows that will be used throughout the city!



Snow Plow Design Challenge - Fall 2021



The City of Staunton would like to partner with art classes at each of the Staunton City Schools to design and paint five plow blades (one per school) that will be used to clear streets from the streets this winter. The City of Staunton Public Works Department will be responsible for sealing the paint and will work with art teachers to find the best product. Teachers and students are encouraged to create scenes or designs of the theme of "Snow Day" or "Winter Olympics". Get ready to awe Staunton citizens with the artwork from Staunton City students!

WHAT: **Plow Blade Design Challenge**
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WHO: Students in grades K-12

WHEN: Submit design for scoring by Friday, November 12
Scoring occurs from November 15 - 19 with final selection by November 19
Painting of plow occurs sometime between November 22 - December 17.

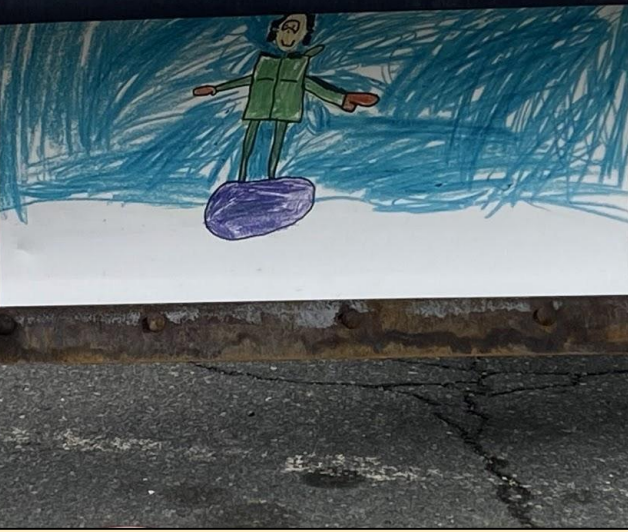
