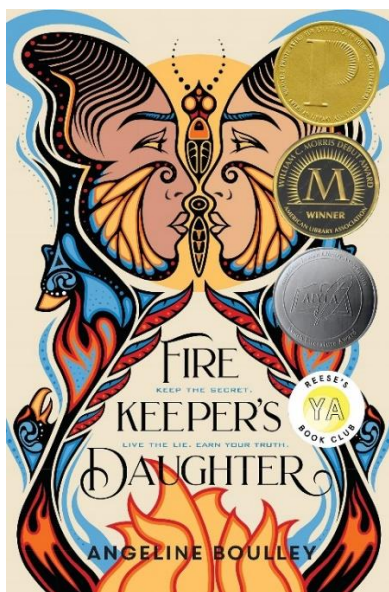


Award-Winning Young Adult Books of 2022
