

Children's Art Show Instructions & Info to Send in with Your Project

- Participants must be in the Kindergarten through Fifth Grade age range.
- Choose a book from our library and read it yourself, read it with a grown-up, or have it read to you. Then create a drawing, painting, or sculpture based on a character or something else from the story.
- Due to limited space, we are only accepting the first 24 entries. Please limit the "footprint" of your entry to a maximum of 24 inches in width and 15 inches in length.
- If you want your entry to be matted/framed, that must be done by you; the library will not be providing that service.
- All artwork must be brought to the library no later than 4:30pm on Thursday, 1/19/23. Please submit artwork to Karen Cunningham, Assistant Children's Programmer, or staff at one of the two circulation desks.
- The art show itself will run from 1/23/23 through 2/5/23; please pick up artwork no later than 4:30pm on 2/12/23.
- This is an unjudged, passive art show so no prizes will be awarded, but each child who enters artwork will receive a Certificate of Participation.
