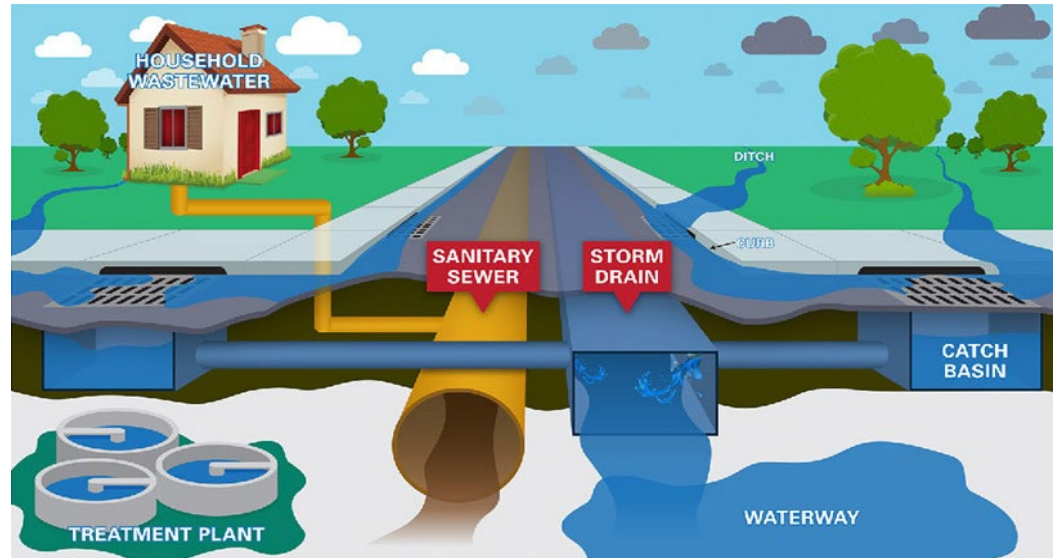


Environmental Programs Division

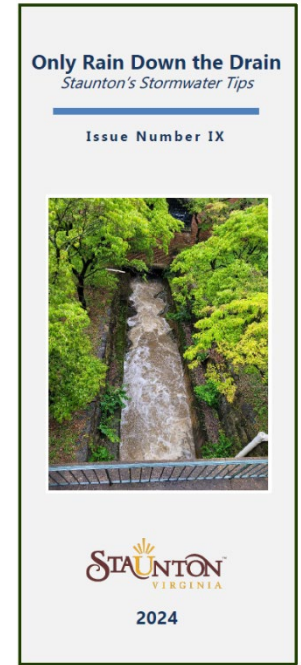
This division is responsible for the development, implementation, and enforcement of Staunton's [Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System \(MS4\) Program](#) to ensure regulatory compliance with the requirements set forth by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

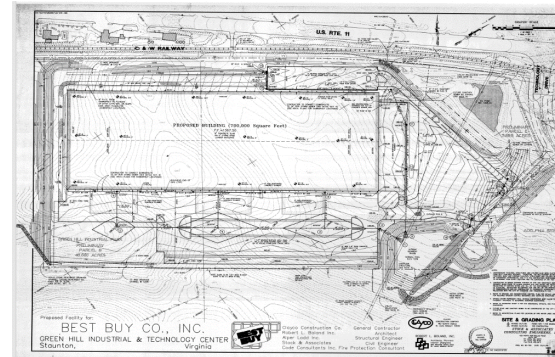
The MS4 Program Plan must include the following measures:

- Public education and outreach
- Public involvement and participation
- Illicit discharge detection and elimination
- Construction site runoff and control
- Post-construction runoff control
- Pollution prevention and good housekeeping



Environmental Programs Responsibilities

- Create/distribute educational materials on stormwater pollution reduction.
- Review site plans, planned unit developments, and plats for compliance with VESMP state standards and specifications.
- Bi-weekly inspections of active construction sites for compliance with VESMP regulations.
- Inspections of private and publicly-owned Best Management Practices (BMPs).
- MS4 compliance projects to meet Nutrient Pollution Reduction Requirements (Ex. [Gypsy Hill Park Stream Restoration](#)).

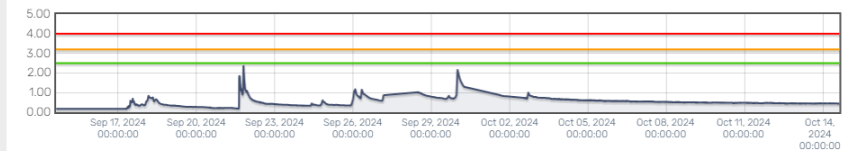

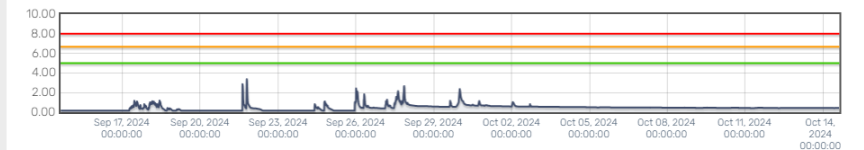
