WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT THIS BIN?

This trash bin is provided to you at
no charge by Staunton Public
Works for residential trash
collection at your address.

Use this bin for your weekly
household trash pickup.

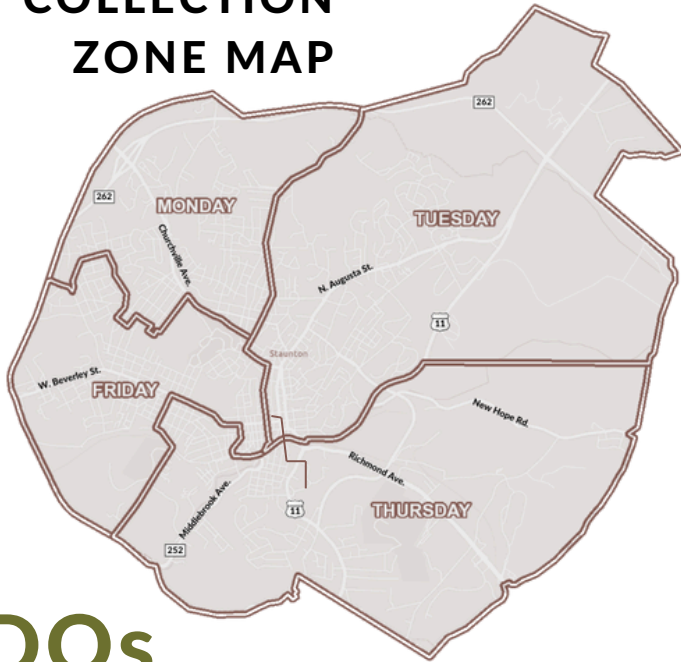
Staunton sanitation trucks have
mechanical tipper arms to empty
these specific trash bins.

In residential areas, only trash bins
with the Staunton Public Works
logo will be collected.

These bins are better for city trash
service and provide the following
benefits:

- Increased safety for sanitation crews
- Cleaner streets & stormwater systems
- Improved collection operation & efficiency
- No potential damage to personal bin
- Improved curb appeal on trash day

DOs

- Put **all trash** in a **trash bag** in the trash bin.
- Keep the lid closed - this helps keep trash in, and water and critters out.
- Put your bin out for pickup **by 6:30 a.m.** on trash day, but no earlier than dusk the day before.
- Store your bin near your home when it is not your trash day.
- Continue recycling at the recycling center.
- Utilize the landfill (free for Staunton residents) when you have too much trash.
- Only **cardboard** will be collected outside of the bin. It must be flattened, bundled, and placed beside your bin (note: this will be collected as trash, not recycled).
- Write your address number, or use adhesive numbers, on the inside of the lid.
- Purchase & place yellow bag tags on extra bags of trash outside the bin for pickup.

DON'Ts

- Mark the bins in any other way.
- Use other trash bins.
- Use the bin for yard debris or anything other than trash.
- Take the bin with you when you move. It belongs to the address, not the occupant.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What if I need a different size, or extra trash bin?

Try using the trash bin provided to the service address for a few trash pickups, while recycling what you can at the Recycling Center. If you would still like to change, call Public Works (540.332.3892) or fill out the [online form](#) to request an exchange or additional bin. Public Works will make changes as inventory allows. There will be an additional monthly fee for a 2nd 95-gallon bin.

How do I dispose of a personal trash bin?

The city will collect old bins as trash if you cannot think of a way to reuse your bin (storage, compost, rain barrel, taking recycling to the recycling center, etc.) Clearly mark it as trash and put the empty bin near your city-issued bin for trash collection.

What should I do with yard waste?

The city has a yard waste collection program that residents can [enroll](#) in if they choose. Participants receive a dedicated, different 95-gallon bin specifically for yard waste that will be picked up once per month. This **yard waste must be unbagged**.

What about heavy trash / appliance pickup?

The city offers two [heavy trash](#) pickups each year. One in the spring & one in the fall. Check the newsroom for specific dates.

What about occasional extra trash?

For trash that won't fit in your bin, buy a bag tag sticker for your extra bag. Stickers are available at City Hall, Public Works, or [by mail](#) for \$1 each.
