Bin Delivery Status

Initial Bin Deliveries:

- Full roll-out anticipated by end of this week
- Bin delivery reconciliation will begin following full roll-out; responsibility of contractor

Program Review:

- Trash must be bagged, in City bin, with lid closed
- Bag tag must be affixed to each additional bag
- Bag tags can be purchased for \$1 at City Hall, Public Works, or ordered on the City website





Frequent Resident Questions



How do I get rid of my old bin?

Place it curbside and clearly mark it as trash

What happens if the policy isn't followed?

Non-compliance protocols/hangtag notifications

How do change my bin size or add a second bin?

Contact Public Works or sign up on the City's website.

\$12/month fee applies for second bins.

Is there assistance for people with disabilities or who need extra help?

Contact Public Works for a special placement/assistance application

Next Phase: Residential Yard Waste

Interest to-date:

- 220+ households have opted in to-date

How to sign up:

- Contact Public Works or sign up on City website
- Customers will pay a \$50 refundable deposit for the bin

Program Review:

- Must opt in and pay bin deposit
- Free service
- Monthly pick-up
