

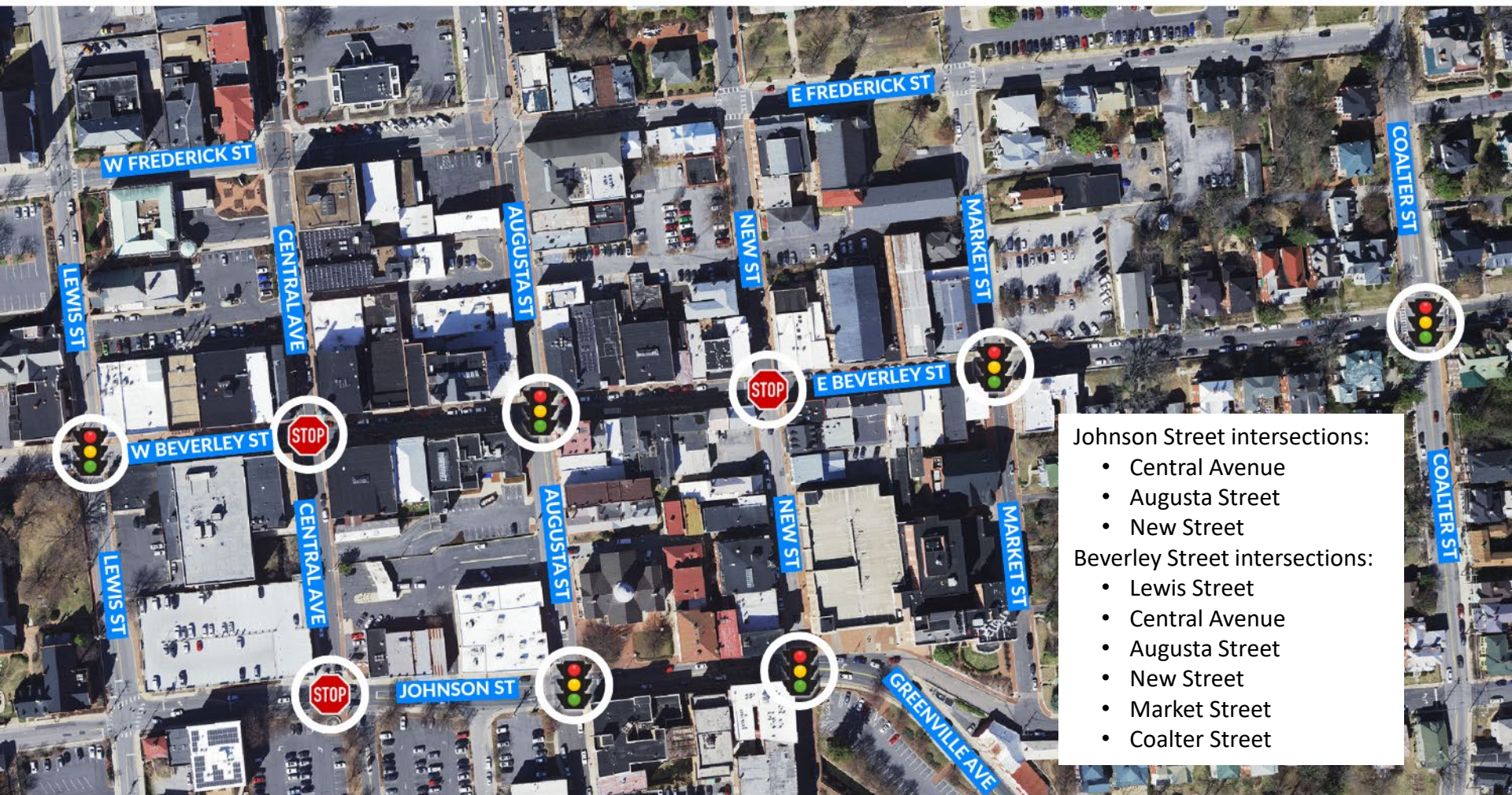


Beverley Street Demonstration Project and HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) Intersections update

Planned Features

- Pedestrian signal push buttons
- Walk/Don't Walk signals on all corners
- New Traffic Signal equipment
- Higher Visibility crosswalks
- Upgraded ADA ramps installed on curb extensions along Beverley Street

Planned Timeline

- Advertisement for Construction: Summer 2027
- Construction start: Fall 2027

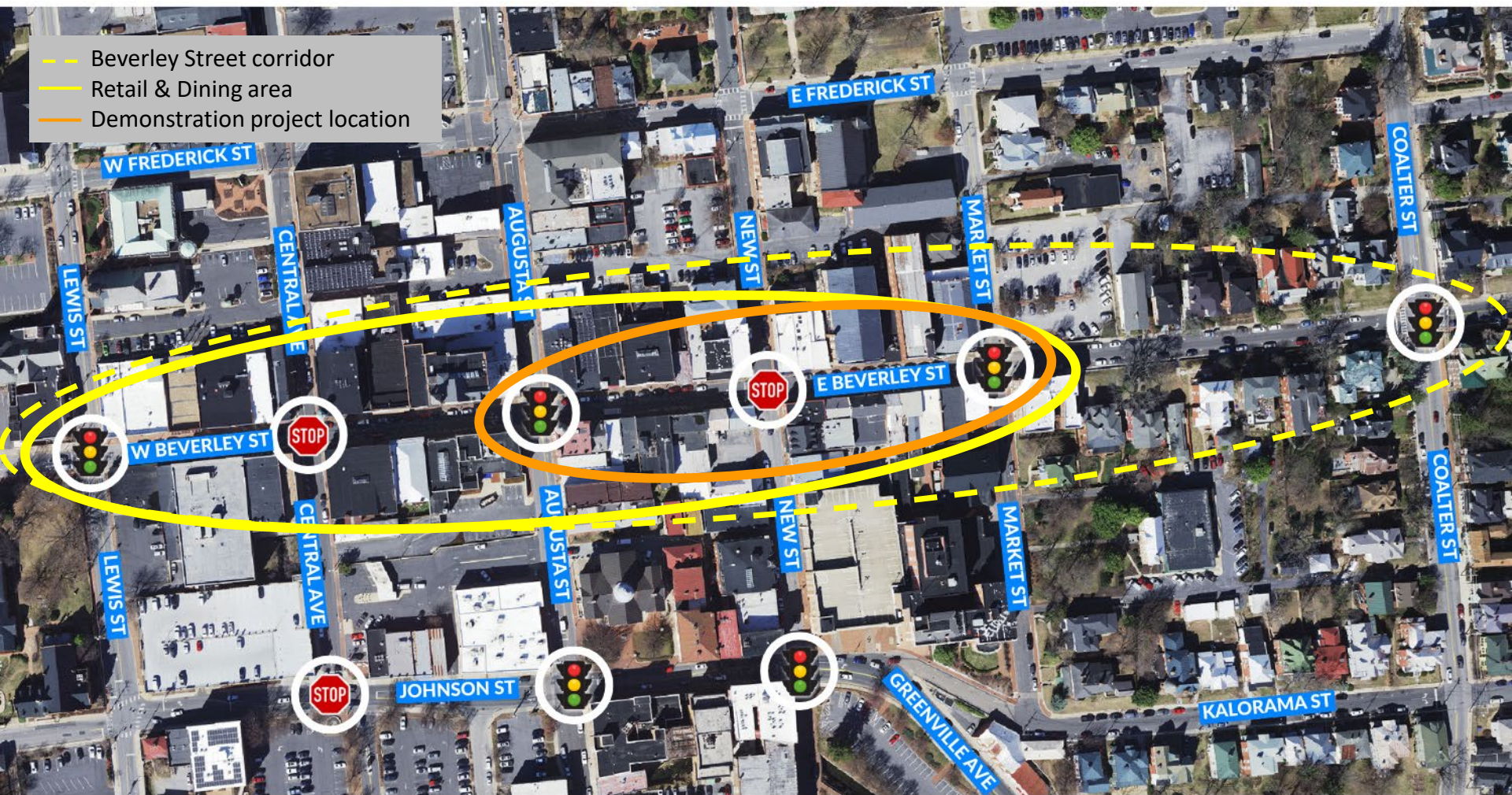

Beverley Street Demonstration Project

This Summer (2026)
The city will do a grant-funded demonstration project, closing one travel lane on a two-block stretch of Beverley between Augusta Street and Market Street. Pedestrians will be able to take over the space for one month (planning for June!).



- Lane blocked off by delimiters
- Both blocks will have a loading zone
- Benches, trees, and shrubs added to make space inviting → DIY features (nothing permanent)



Why?
The Summer 2027 improvements will include curb extensions that will narrow Beverley Street down at each intersection to a single lane for cars.



This design:

- shortens the crossing distance for pedestrians, and
- increases safety and visibility for everyone

Next Summer (2027)
Six intersections along Beverley Street will undergo pedestrian improvements:



- Pedestrian signals and buttons
- Higher visibility crosswalks
- Improved ADA corner ramps

This change in traffic flow will allow the city to reimagine the spaces dedicated to people and to cars.
