

LANDSCAPE ADVISORY BOARD

AUTHORITY: By action of City Council, June 25, 1987

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: Seven members, citizens, residents, and business owners of the city.

TERM OF OFFICE: Three year terms. No term limitations.

MEETINGS: Monthly, on dates established by the Board.

PURPOSE: It shall be the responsibility of the Board to:

- a. Serve to enhance the public participation in the beautification of the city through landscape improvements;
- b. Act as an advocate for both public and private landscaping, assisting in the coordination of both;
- c. Provide advisory oversight to the amendment and implementation of the Comprehensive Landscape Master Plan;
- d. Assist with the education of the public on matters of public landscaping through materials, public appearances and media exposure as appropriate;
- e. Act in an advisory and advocacy role to the city horticulturist, city manager and city council;
- f. Perform as required in Section 26-69 of the Staunton City Code.

NOTE: By action of Council, October 22, 1992, Board membership increased from 5 to 6 members. By action of Council, December 14, 1995, Board membership increased from 6 to 7 members. Statement of purpose amended 2/11/99 by action of City Council. By action of Council, October 23, 2008, membership reduced from 7 to 6 members and term limitations removed.
