

LIBRARY BOARD

AUTHORITY: Section 42.1-35, State Code; Section 2.75.010, City Code

NUMBER MEMBERS: Five (5)

TERM OF OFFICE: Four (4) years

PURPOSE: The Library Board shall serve in an advisory capacity to the Librarian on the selection of reading, recorded and related materials. The Board evaluates priorities of different library materials and programs and encourages optimum utilization of the Library programs by the citizenry of the community. The Board shall have the right to accept donations, gifts, demises, and bequests of money, tangible and intangible property and real estate, to use such or the income therefrom for the benefit of the public library. The Board will work closely with the library staff in the purchasing of materials. Persons selected for the library board should have an interest in and knowledge of the areas provided for the general public by the library.
