

RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION

AUTHORITY: Resolution - Staunton City Council, September 21, 1972

NUMBER MEMBERS: Nine (9)

TERM OF OFFICE: Three (3) years

REGULAR MEETING DATE: On an “as needed” basis, as determined by the Director of Parks and Recreation.

PURPOSE: The purpose established by Council for the Recreational Advisory commission is to evaluate the adequacy of the recreation programs and facilities of the community both City operated and privately operated, and to report their findings and recommendations to City Council. Reports shall be made at times as conditions may dictate; however, the reports will have to be made at least annually in the month of December. The commission shall consist of nine (9) members appointed by City Council. No special requirements are listed or indicated for appointment to the Commission.
