

SHENANDOAH VALLEY AIRPORT COMMISSION

AUTHORITY: Chapter 628, Acts of Assembly 1956, Article Two, Chapter 3, Title 5, State Code

NUMBER MEMBERS: One (1) from Staunton

TERM OF OFFICE: Three (3) years

PURPOSE: The Shenandoah Valley Airport Commission is established for the Counties of Rockingham, Augusta and the Cities of Harrisonburg, Waynesboro and Staunton. The Commission shall consist of one member from each of the participating counties and cities appointed by the governing bodies thereof respectively. The Commission has the power to manage and control the airport property and its facilities, including, but in no way by limitation of, the authority to enter into leases, as lessor for any land or facility based within such property, but no extending over a period of more than two years including renewals unless approved by the governing bodies, to contract the mail cargo and passenger service with the United States government and commercial airlines and others to enter into employment contracts for any purpose embraced within its authority. The Commission may enter into contracts with concessioners, but not extending a period of more than two (2) years unless approved by such governing bodies and may contract for all necessary services establish and enforce all rules and regulations pertaining to the use of the airport and its facilities, and establish and charge fees or other charges for the use of the airport, the landing field, and accompanying facilities. The Commission may accept gifts and grants from the State or any political subdivision thereof, and from the United States and any of its agencies or from any person or corporation. The Joint Airport Commission shall keep proper records of its operations, dealings, transactions and meetings, which record shall be open to inspection by the participating counties and cities at all times.
