Acquire, organize, and provide access and guidance to a wide variety of information and materials which help to fulfill the intellectual, educational, social and recreational needs of all the people in the city.

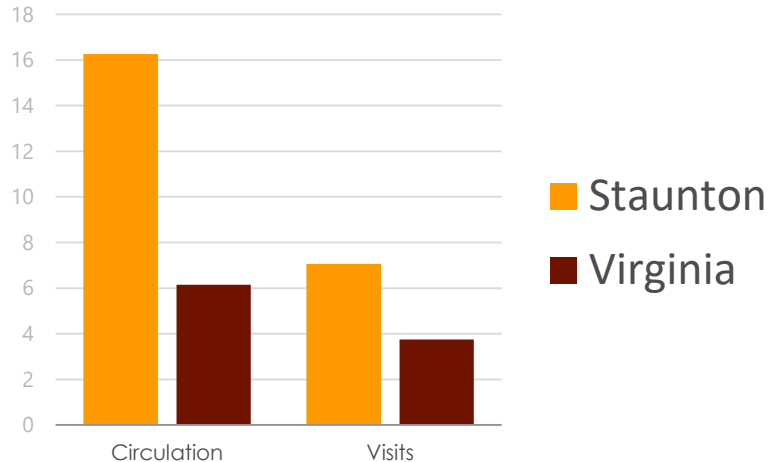
Staunton Public Library is also a member of the Valley Libraries Connection.
