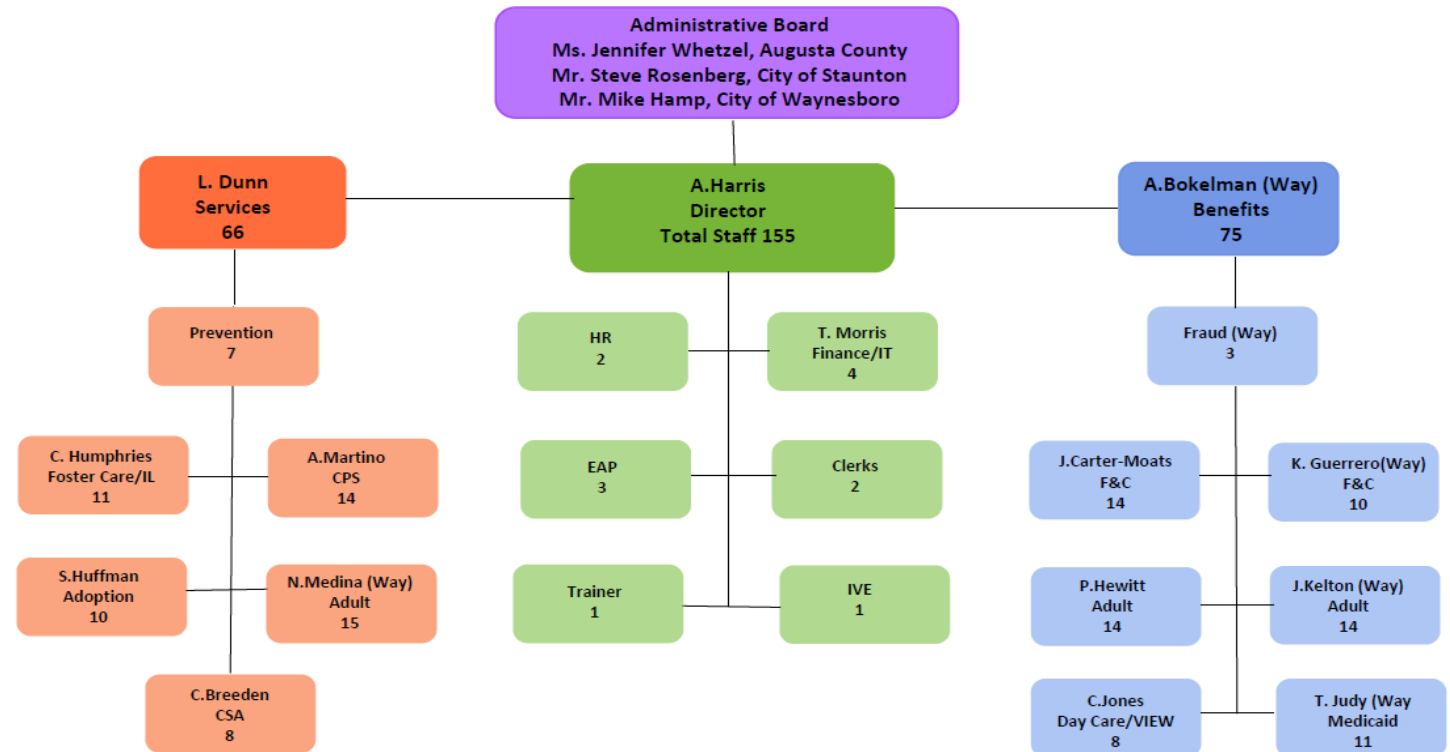

BENEFIT PROGRAMS

Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)

Provides monetary assistance to children, and their families, in need.

General Relief

Provides assistance for families with unrelated minors

Energy Assistance Program (EAP)

Provides heating/cooling and crisis assistance to low income households.



MEDICAID

ASSISTS WITH HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE FOR LOW INCOME OR MEDICALLY NEEDY INDIVIDUALS.

Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program

Provides supplemental nutritional assistance for low-income families.

Burial Assistance

Provides burial assistance for those with no means to pay burial expenses.



Virginia's Initiative for Employment not Welfare (VIEW)

Assists, trains, and prepares TANF recipients for employment.

Child Care Services

Provides quality child care services.

Fraud Referrals and Collections



SERVICE PROGRAMS

Adult Protective Services

Investigations of adult abuse, neglect, and exploitation of elderly, disabled, and incapacitated adults. Provides services to reduce the risk to adults and assist adults to remain independent.

Child Protective Services

Investigations of child abuse/neglect. Services opened to families determined at further risk of abuse/neglect.

Foster Care and Adoption

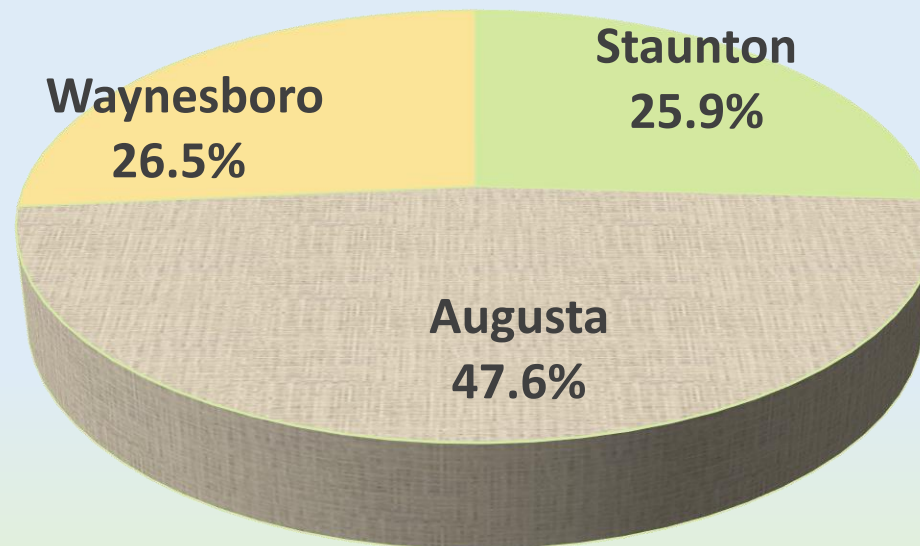
Provides a safe home for children coming into care with an emphasis on seeking permanent placements for the child.
