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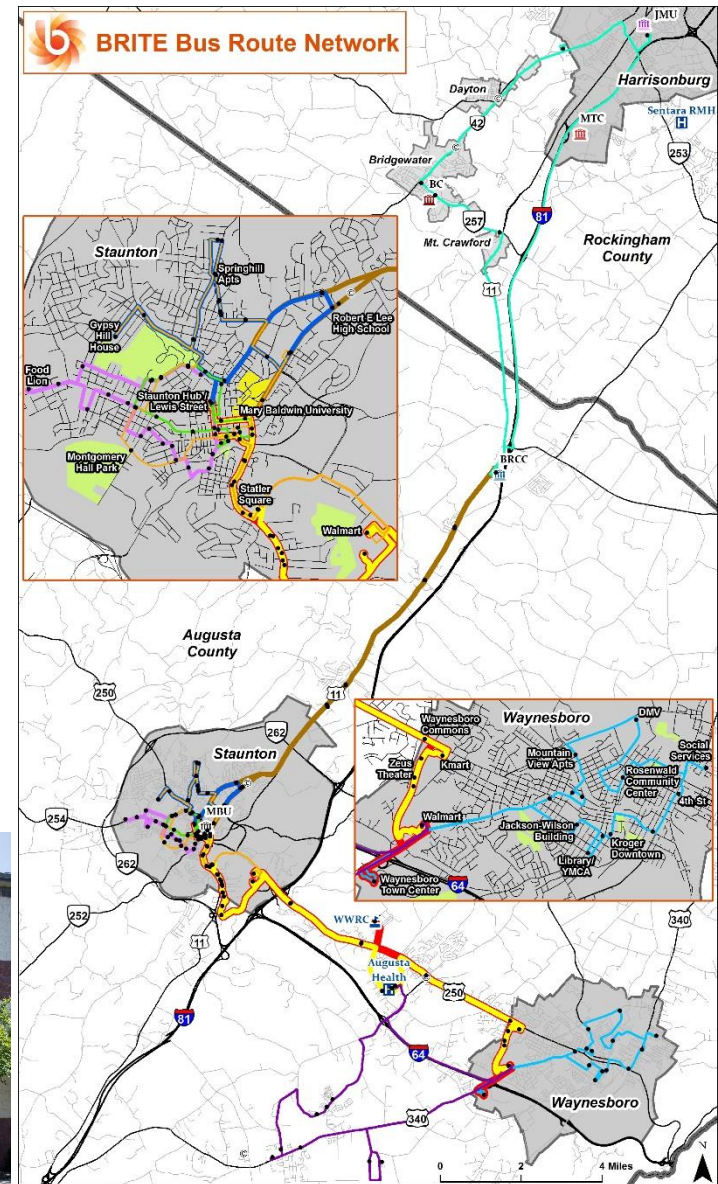
History of Transit in the Region

- 1970's – First public bus service in Staunton
- 1988 – Two local hospitals merged; Augusta Health pledged to support public transit
- 1992 – CATS formed to provide human services transportation
- 2002 – Virginia Regional Transit became service provider
- 2013 – CSPDC becomes recipient of Federal and State transit funds

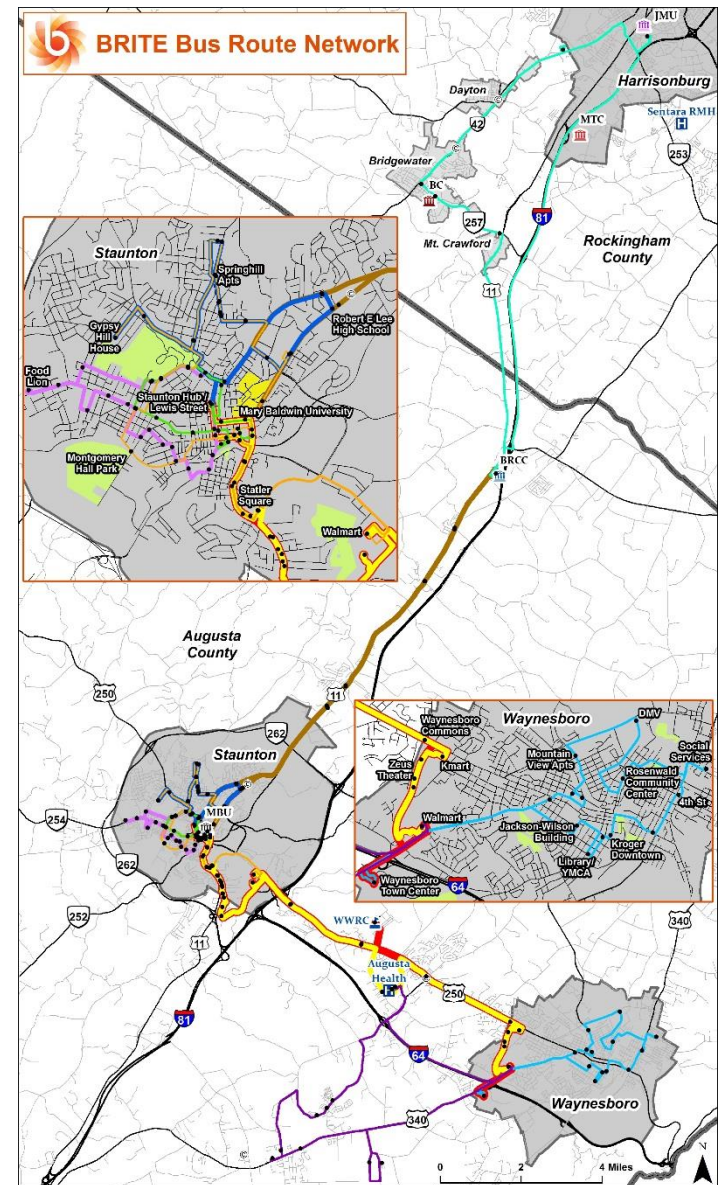
Who rides the bus and why?

 - Over 260,000 passenger trips provided

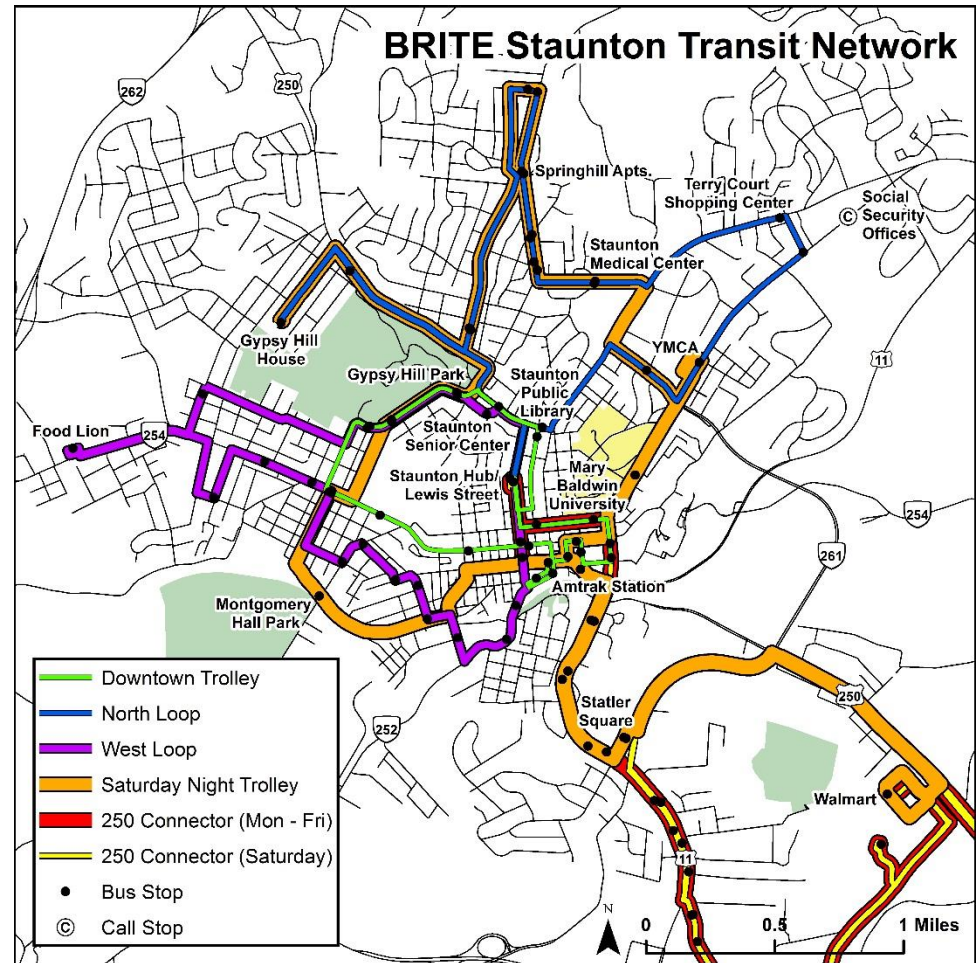

Staunton Routes

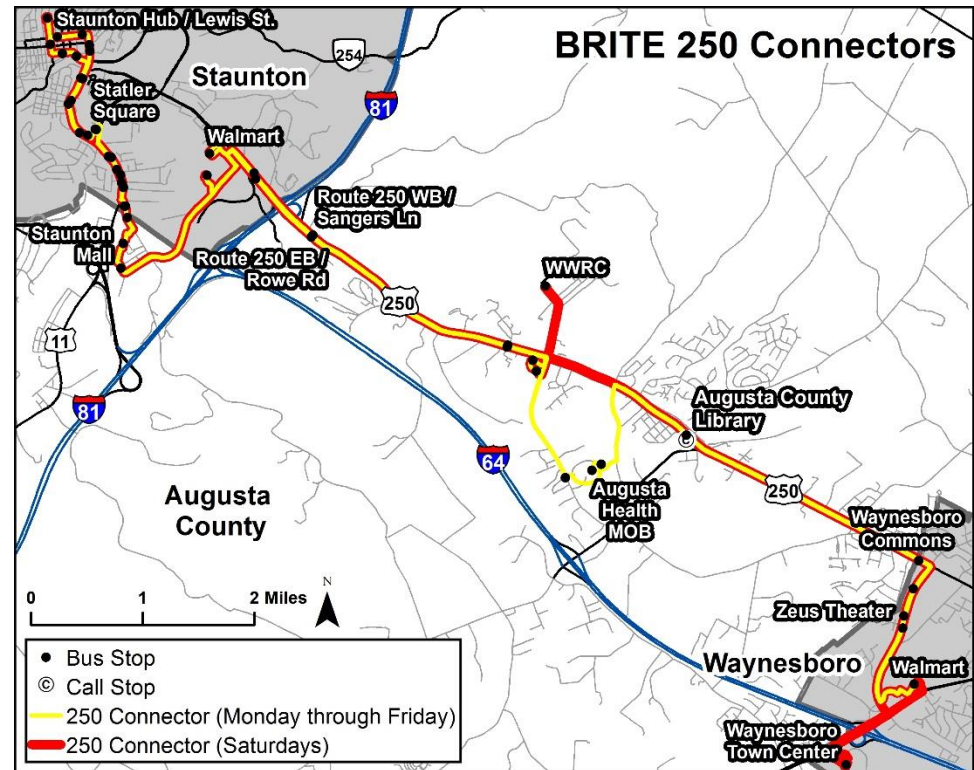
- Downtown Trolley

250 Connector

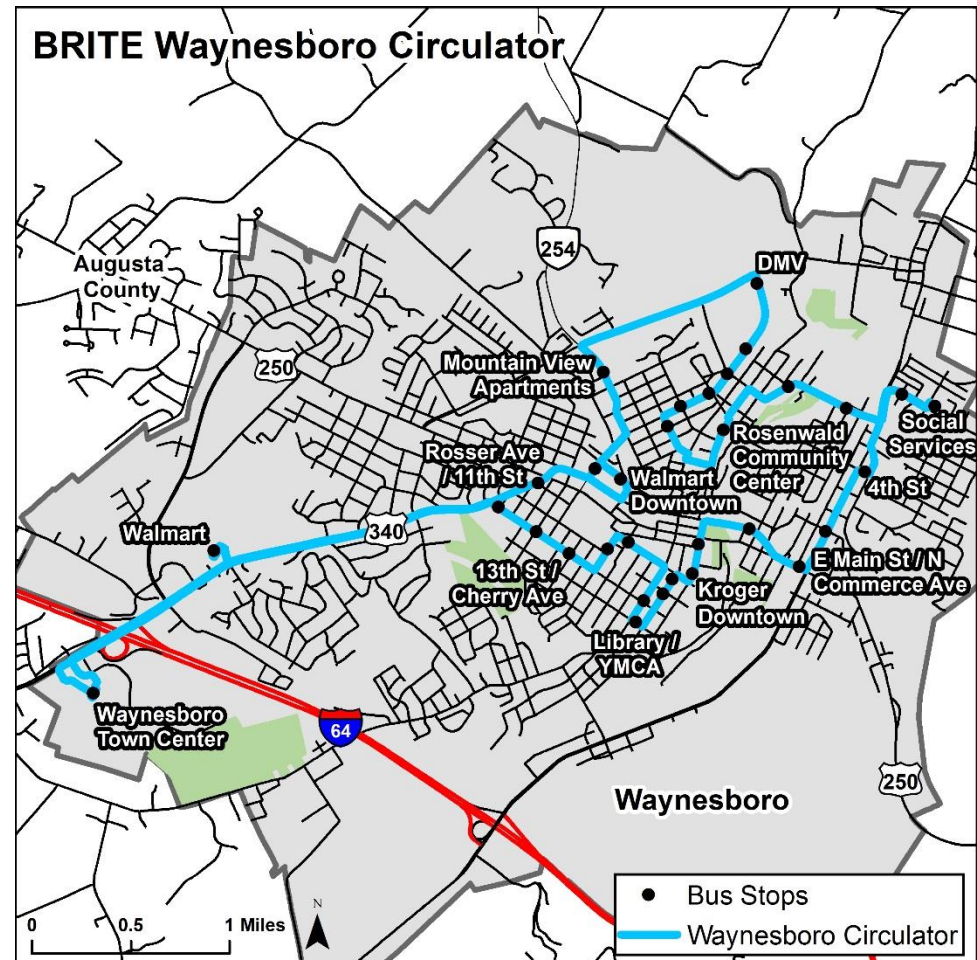
- Eastbound & Westbound
 - Monday-Friday, 7:30am – 9:30pm
 - Saturday, 8:30am – 7:30pm
- Connects to the Staunton routes, the Waynesboro Circulator, the Stuarts Draft Link, and the Blue Ridge Community College Shuttle



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Waynesboro Circulator

- Circulator
 - Monday-Friday 6:30am – 6:22pm
- The Waynesboro Circulator and the Stuarts Draft Link connect to the 250 Connector and each other at the Walmart (Waynesboro), when they run at the same time.

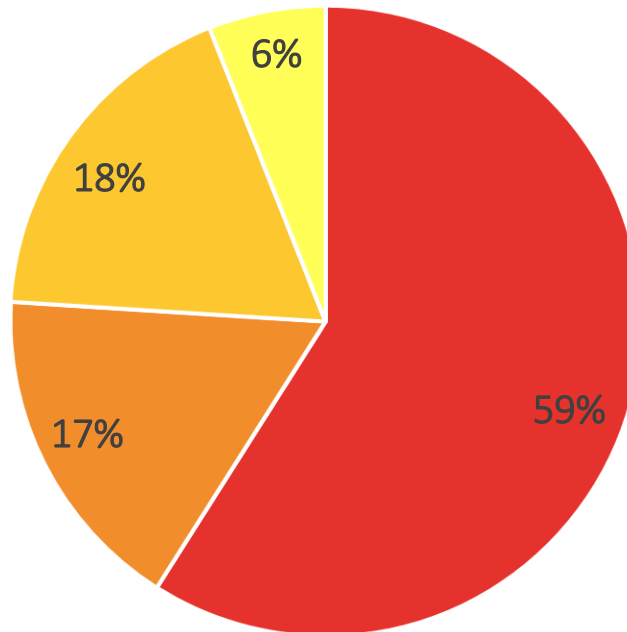

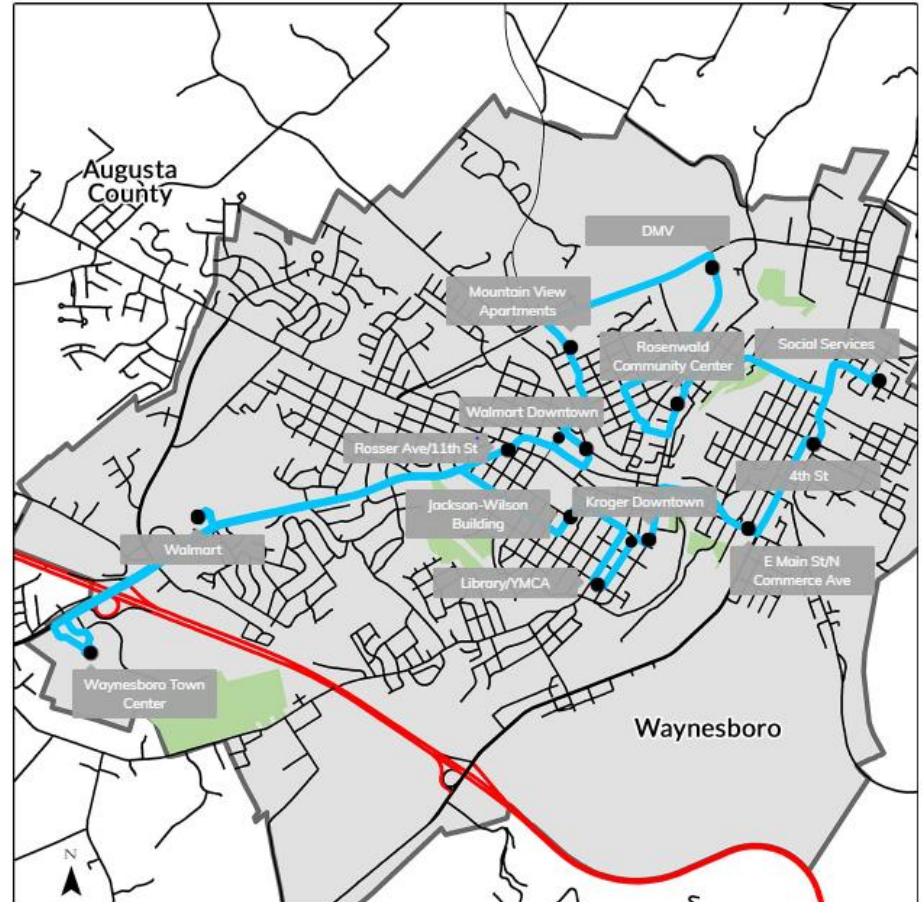

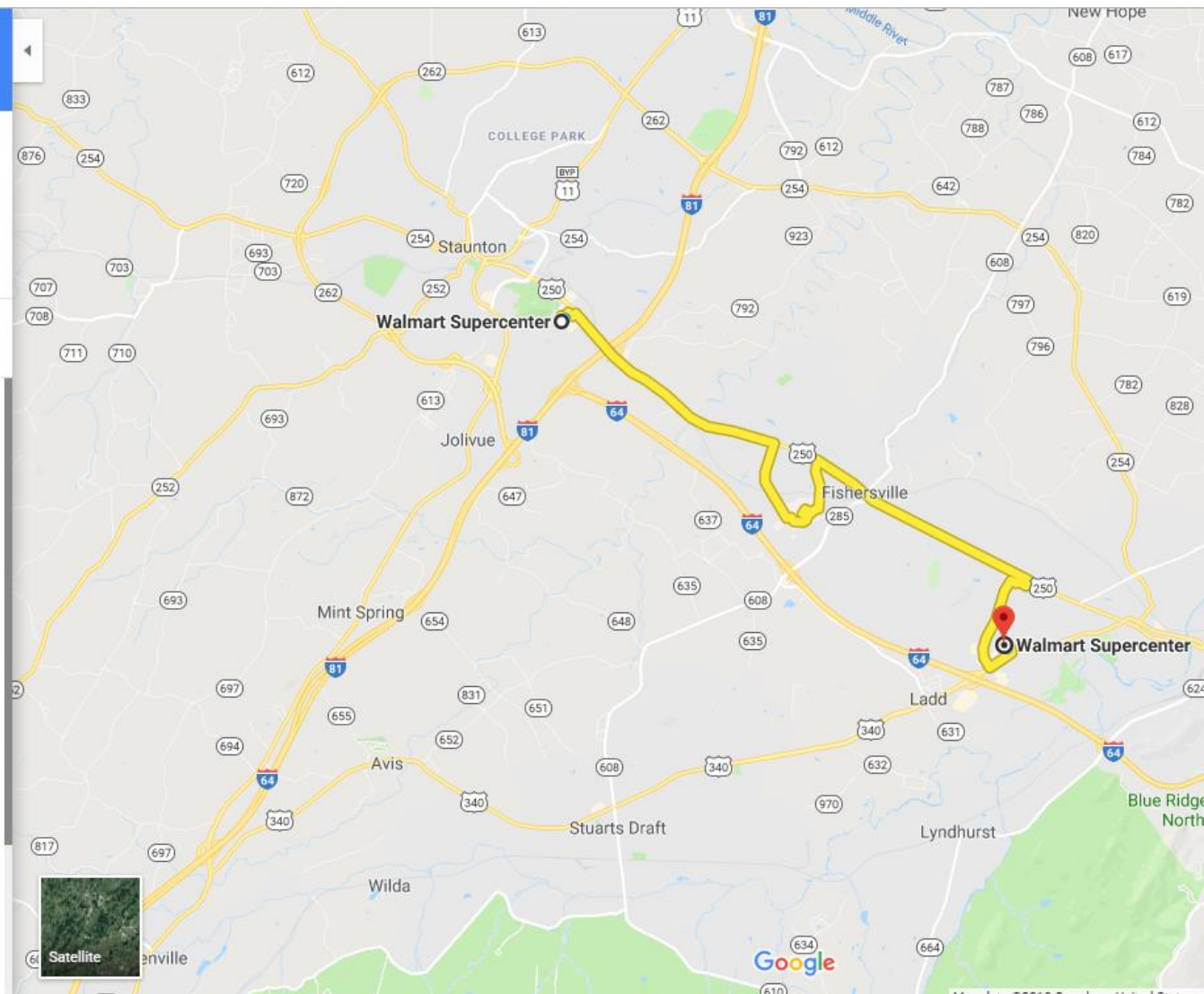
