Staunton Public Library is also a member of the Valley Libraries Connection.

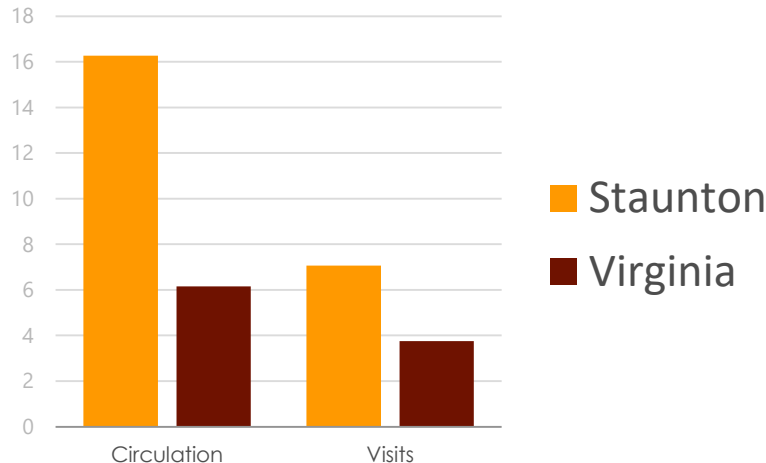
- ◆ \$1,183,729 budget
