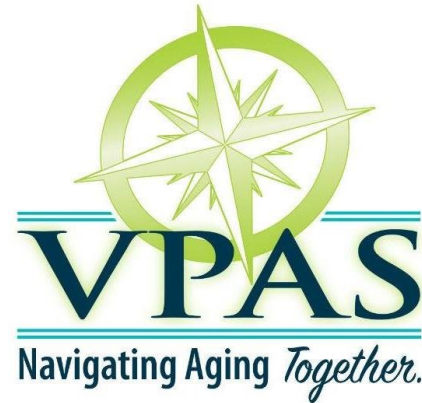


Senior Assistance:
