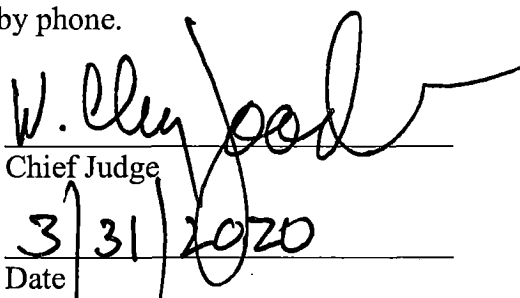


VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE CITY OF STAUNTON

IN RE: ADMISSION TO STAUNTON CIRCUIT COURT AND STAUNTON CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE

ORDER

Pursuant to Virginia Code Section 8.01-4, in order to promote the safety of the court facilities and clerk's office and in response to the Covid 19 pandemic it is hereby ORDERED effective immediately until further Order of the Court, that the Sheriff of the City of Staunton and his deputies shall be authorized to deny admission to the Staunton Circuit Court or the Staunton Circuit Court Clerk's Office to any individual that is displaying signs of illness, including but not limited to fever, cough or shortness of breath or who has traveled to an area of concern for infection. If the individual denied admission is a litigant with a pending case on the day said individual is denied admission, he or she shall provide his or her name, current residential address, and current phone number to the Sheriff or his deputies in order to permit the Court to notify said individual of the next hearing date and time of his or her case. The case will be continued by the Court and the litigant will be mailed a new court date and time. Any questions can be addressed by contacting the clerk's office by phone.
