



Online Borrower Registration (COVID-19 Temporary Procedure)

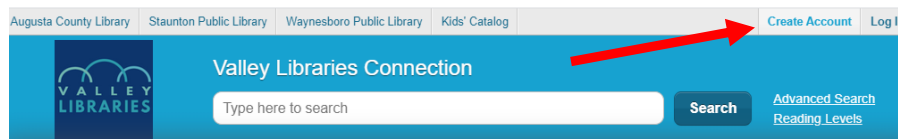
Don't have a Valley Libraries Connection (VLC) card and need access to the library's many online resources? Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and our extended closure, Staunton Public Library is allowing you to sign up for a temporary card online.

Who does this help?

- Patrons no longer in the system
- People who have never had a VLC library card

How do you sign up?



1. Visit www.ValleyLibraries.org (see picture above).
2. Click the "Create Account" option in upper right corner, fill out all of the required info, and submit the online form.
3. Call the Staunton Public Library at 540.332.3902 and be ready to confirm your personal details over the phone.
4. A staff member will assign you a library card number and list you as a temporary user. Have a pen handy – you'll need to write your new number down!
5. Your new physical library card will be held at the Staunton Public Library's first floor check-out desk.
6. When we re-open, bring photo ID to claim your card. Minors under age 18 without ID will need to be ready to confirm all personal details on the card to claim it.
